The Forest Practices Board (FPB) is B.C.'s independent watchdog for sound forest and range practices, reporting its findings and recommendations directly to the public and government. The board audits forest and range practices on public lands and appropriateness of government enforcement. The presentation will highlight findings from recent reports by the FPB, discuss trends and emerging issues, and offer some personal observations.

Prior to becoming Chair of the FPB in May 2010, Al Gorley operated Triangle Resources Incorporated, a small consulting firm based in Victoria, BC. He has held a number of operational and management positions with the BC Forest Service, Forest Renewal BC, and is a past president of the McGregor Model Forest Association. Al also served with the Association of BC Forest Professionals on council and as President in 1992.
